Birdshot Uveitis Society of North America (BUSNA) and Fight for Sight (FFS) announce that they have partnered to offer a \$2,500 research grant for Summer 2023.

This grant will be awarded for the study of birdshot uveitis. Given how rare birdshot is, the award may also be given to study posterior uveitis. The goal of this grant is to promote research into this disease and ultimately to prevent sight loss.

Selection criteria will be provided by the FFS [Scientific Review Committee \(SRC\)](#). FFS terms, guidelines, review, and funding mechanisms of FFS' present grant structure will apply.
